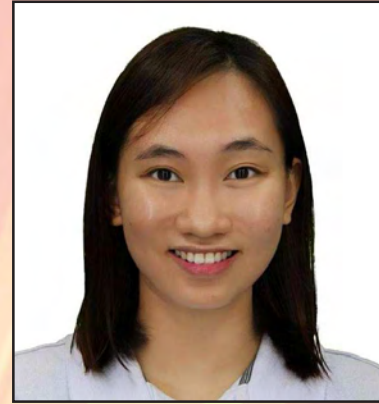
SCMA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- The SCMA Scholarship Program is one of the most important programs that receive funding from the various fund-raising events at SCMA. The annual dinner-dance and the golf tournament are major sources of funding for the Program. The Scholarship Program has both a small local Southern California-based and a larger and older Philippine-based component. The local component provides a one-time monetary award to a student graduating from a Southern California high school, or to an active SCMA member pursuing graduate studies. From 1999 to present, there have been four recipients of the local award and 36 recipients of the Philippine-based award.
- The Philippine-based component provides tuition assistance for students enrolled in our old Alma Mater, Mapua Institute of Technology, which was just renamed to Mapua University last year. Mapua applicants are usually 3rd and 4th year engineering students and nominated by the school to SCMA. The evaluation of the applications and selection of the scholars is based on their Grade Weighted Average, Financial Need, and Essay, and is performed by members of the SCMA Scholarship Committee. The outgoing Committee members are Dan Nable (Chairman), Ross Papilla (Assistant Treasurer), Tony Ballesteros, Joe Rigonan, Cecille Brod and Nene Irlandez. The incoming Committee members are Glee Quiaot (Chairman), John Christian Villareal (Assistant Treasurer), Berwyn Salazar, Tino Quiaot, Tony Ballesteros and Joe Rigonan. 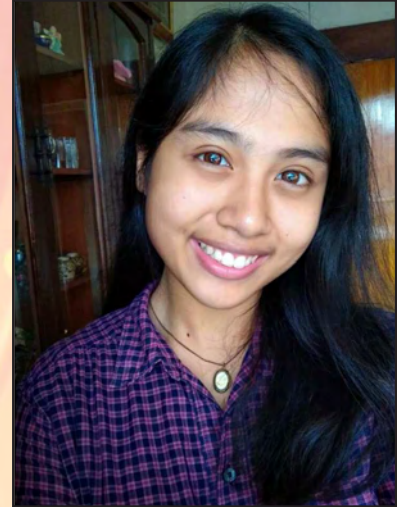

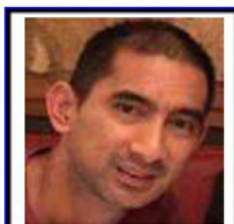
