

#### SCMA 2023 Scholarship Program Status Update:

SCMA's Scholarship Program is one of the most important programs as stated in our Mission Statement. We believe that a good education is a ticket to a more fulfilling life not only for the student but also for their families and others around them. Although you may be aware of our scholarship program for smart and ambitious but financially disadvantaged students at our old Alma Mater, SCMA also has a local (Southern California-based) scholarship program. To date we've had 42 Mapua scholars and our last batch of four scholars have just graduated or will soon be graduating (see pictures). We are very proud of our scholars and their sponsors, and our donors and supporters.

We are in the process of requesting a fresh batch of Scholarship candidates from Mapua University. We are also in the process of updating our guidelines for our local scholarship program. We currently have substantial funds due in part to three new and popular fundraising methods: the Scholarship Matching Fund, the Adopt-A Scholar, and the Qualified Charitable Distribution programs. Donations received through these programs are 100% tax-deductible due to our 501(c)(3) status as a Charitable Non-profit Organization. Giving back to the community is the main purpose of our existence as an organization. Recently we have received substantial Scholarship Fund donations from Lourdes Cronin, BA'65. and Joe Rigonan, ME'62. #### **SCMA Free EIT Review Course and Professional Development:**

SCMA continues to fulfill its core mission of providing career advancement assistance for members and the community. This is done by conducting Free California Engineering Exam review classes, mentoring, networking, and job placement support to individuals in the engineering and technical fields. Engineer- in-Training (EIT) review classes for young engineers and alumni aspiring to pass the Fundamentals of Engineering exam and be granted a California EIT Certificate is one of the most popular of SCMA's public service programs.

Currently, SCMA has started the EIT review classes, which were facilitated by SCMA members and volunteers who have passed the exam and/or have a mastery of specific subject areas. We are now in the process of resuming the course and are looking for students and instructors.
